SCHOLARSHIPS, GRANTS, AND WORK-STUDY

SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS

- **Amos Booth French Honors Scholarship:** In honor of Amos Booth, esteemed teacher, director, and second president of IAU College, IAU offers a merit-based scholarship to eligible semester students who have been accepted into the French Honors Program. Must have a 3.5 GPA or higher. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$1,500.
- **Dean's Scholarship:** Awarded to students with outstanding academic achievement. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. Scholarships range from \$1,500 to \$2,500.
- **Diversity Scholarship:** Awarded to students with outstanding academic achievement and who, through sharing their varied cultural perspectives, will enhance the experience of all IAU students and the excellence of IAU College. Open to students who have been traditionally under-represented on study abroad programs. Scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$2,000.
- **Pi Delta Phi, National French Honors Society:** In partnership with Pi Delta Phi, IAU College is proud to offer one full tuition (6-credit) scholarship each summer to qualified students. The candidate is selected by Pi Delta Phi to participate in the IAU College French Honors Program, a comprehensive immersion program for advanced French students.
- **Presidential Scholarship:** Awarded to students with exceptional academic ability who have also demonstrated outstanding out-of-classroom and co-curricular involvement and leadership. Must have a 3.5 GPA or higher. Scholarships range from \$2,500 to \$5,000.
- **The Fantasy Fountain Fund:** Each summer IAU College works with the Fantasy Fountain Fund to provide a full tuition scholarship to qualified students enrolled full-time in IAU College's Marchutz School of Fine Arts.
- **Constantin Christofides Art & Art History Scholarship:** In honor of Dr. Constantin Christofides, retired distinguished professor of humanities, this scholarship is available to semester and summer students majoring in art or art history. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$1,000.
- **Judith L. Rice International Relations & Global Studies Scholarship:** Awarded to students majoring in political science, international relations or global studies with outstanding academic achievement. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. Scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$2,000.
- **Alumni Grant:** IAU College welcomes and encourages alumni to return to Aix, either to enroll in programs that drew them to IAU in the first place or to experience IAU through one of the many new offerings. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$1,000.
- **Herbert Maza Academic Year Grant:** In honor of Dr. Herbert Maza, co-founder and first president of IAU, qualified students who enroll for an academic year (2 consecutive semesters) receive a grant of \$1,000.
- **January Term & Spring Semester Grant:** Students who enroll in a January term and a spring semester consecutively are eligible to receive a \$500 grant for the spring semester.

WORK-STUDY

IAU College offers several work-study opportunities each semester and summer term in Aix-en-Provence, France. Approximately 10-12 hours per week, eligible students will work closely with faculty, staff, and students to fulfill various duties throughout their term including but not limited to IT assistance, event preparation, social media work and more.

APPLICATION

Students interested in applying for a scholarship must submit a scholarship application, essay, an additional letter of recommendation from a professor or advisor (this is an addition to the one submitted for the admissions application) describing why he/she should be considered for the scholarship.
