

**2/ The European Dream** (to November 9)

After the First World War and its horrors, several important figures have tried to put in perspective the centennial of the European dream of the United States, first and foremost the pilgrim of peace, Aristide Briand, as Chairman and Minister of foreign affairs, but also in the shadows, his chief of staff, Alexis Leger, alias Saint-John Perse. The exhibition highlights the similarities between these two men, and their personal relationship. It puts their project and their work in its historical and human context, from little-known documents, drawn largely from the collections of the Saint-John Perse
