

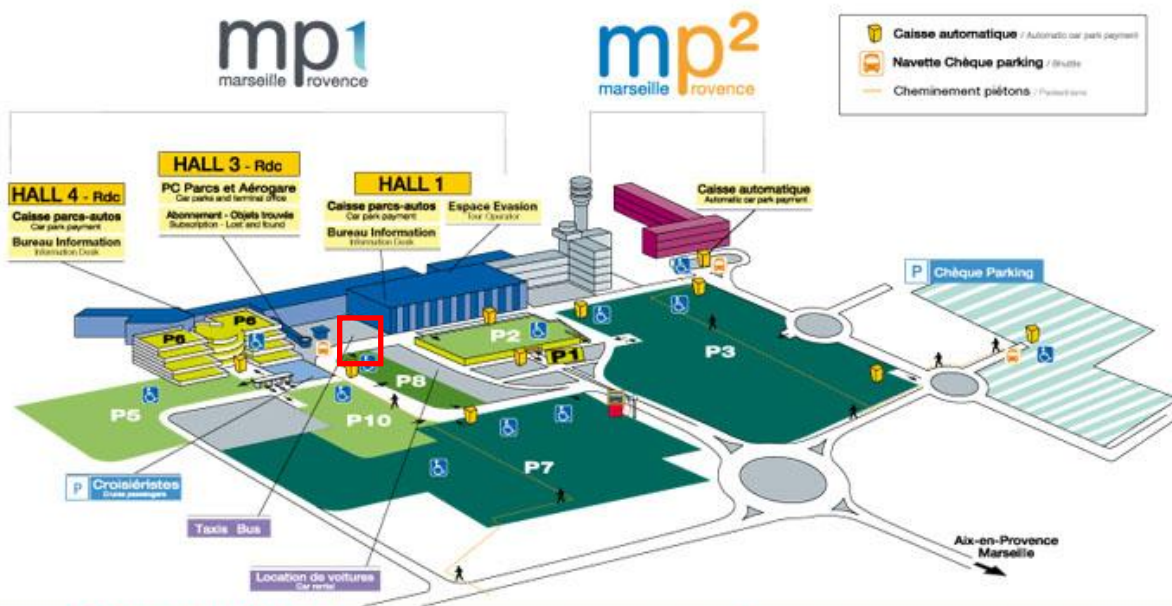
Getting into Aix from the Marseille airport or TGV station

The shuttle to Aix

The shuttle (*navette*) will leave the airport every 30 minutes. It will leave the TGV station every 20 minutes. It will come to the Aix bus station. The trip is about twenty minutes and costs 7 euros from the airport, 4.50 euros from the station. You can pay the driver directly when you board the bus (with euros).

Boarding from the airport

When you have claimed your bags, you may be in Hall 1, Hall 3-4 or Hall mp2. Whichever your case, when you are walking out of the airport to the pick-up and parking areas, the navette will be right between Hall 1 and Hall 3-4 (see red square below). It will make one stop at the TGV station. Make sure you do not get off the bus until the bus station in Aix. This is the end of the line.

This is what the navette looks like. Be careful you do not choose the one to Marseille. Your navette will say "Aix – TGV – Aéroport".

Boarding from the TGV station When you get off the train at the Aix station, follow the signs indicating public transport. If arriving from North of Aix, you should climb the steps, cross over the tracks to the departures (Départs) side of the station and descend to where the cafés and newspaper stands are. Once there, you should see signs for the public transport. To get to where the navette is, you will have to go down the stairs again to where the road traverses under the station. Once on that bus, it will not stop until it gets to Aix.
