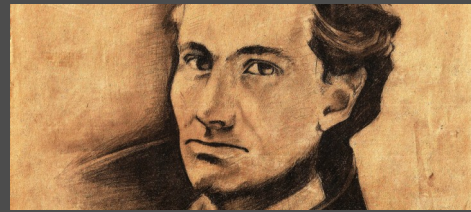

The tradition actually began in 1886 following a Chicago workers strike that demanded the work day be limited to eight hours. It was officially adopted by the American Federation of Labor as a holiday to recognize workers' rights and for France in 1889 by the International Socialist Congress in Paris. President Grover Cleveland officially adopted Labor Day in September in the US to commemorate the Pullman strike and to shore up support from labor unions, rejecting the May 1 date as he feared that it would encourage socialist and anarchist movements of the time.
